Fire extinguishers are located at:

- 1st floor – On the wall in “modern” kitchen, near the door to the old kitchen.
- 2nd floor – On the wall in the landing.
- Attic – At top of stairs, to the right of the door.

Emergency Procedures

In all situations, your safety and the safety of our visitors is important!

In case of fire, **REMAIN CALM**. Clear the building of people, shutting the door behind you. Call:

- 911 for the fire department.
- The Director of Collections, Joe Hammond, 732-688-7112.

If a person falls or is injured and immediate attention is necessary, call:

- 911 to report the emergency, if requested by the injured party or accompanying party.
- The Interim Director, Chuck Jones, 803-403-3031, to notify him of the situation. If you do not get in touch with Chuck, please contact Joe Hammond or Pati Githens.
- Fill out an accident report. Blank forms are located in the cabinet by the front door.

If there is a power failure, notify Headquarters during business hours or the director and you will be advised on proper procedure, depending on the situation.

If you suspect theft, vandalism, or notice damage to the property, call the director, or if not available, the volunteer coordinator, ASAP. You will be directed on proper procedure.

DO NOT CONFRONT ANYONE YOU SUSPECT OF THEFT.

Remember, your personal safety is a primary concern.

Rules and Policies

Call Headquarters on arrival and before closing up on Fridays and Saturdays. On Sundays, call or text Pati Githens, 732-918-1823 on her cell to check in and out.

In your closing phone call, please provide the following information:

- Number of adult visitors.
- Number of child visitors.
- Total fees collected.
- Any issues that came up.
- Any papers that need to be stocked.

All visitors must sign in before their tour and pay appropriate fee unless they are members.
